VOICE 2 (NIMBLE)

Don't worry. They never saw us.

VOICE 3 (ERETH)

VOICE 2 (NIMBLE)

VOICE 3 (ERETH)

VOICE 5 (FLIP)

They do?

VOICE 3 (ERETH)

VOICE 6 (TUMBLE)

Oh, sure. It's down along the bluff a bit.

VOICE 3 (ERETH)

Can you find it?

VOICE 6 (TUMBLE)

I suppose.

VOICE 3 (ERETH)

Then why the mangy muskrat mites if you were so hungry didn't you go look for food there?

VOICE 2 (NIMBLE)

I guess we didn't think of it.

VOICE 5 (FLIP)

We were waiting for Mom.

VOICE 6 (TUMBLE)

VOICE 2 (NIMBLE)

VOICE 5 (FLIP)

Mr. Doormat are ... are you going to be our mother from now on?

VOICE 3 (EARTH)
